1. Create an account at ontariocolleges.ca
2. Pay a \$95 non-refundable application fee
3. Select up to 5 program choices (note that there is a limit of 3 program choices at any one college)

Applying as a Mature Student

You may apply as a mature student if:

- You do not have an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or its equivalent
- AND
- You are 19 years of age or older before the beginning of classes

Key Dates and Deadlines

October 1

- Offers to all programs will start going out to applicants on this date.

November 1

- Confirm your acceptance by this date to ensure your seat is saved in your program of choice.
- Deadline to complete your OSAP application.

November 15

- You must pay a \$500 non-refundable term deposit by this date to hold your seat in your program.

December 20

- Registration opens (select your classes and receive your timetable).

January 7

- First day of classes.
